Subject: CREDITING OF NSTP 1 and NSTP 2 CLASSES TAKEN IN DIFFERENT COLLEGES

The members of the NSTP Council continue to uphold the provision in <u>Memorandum No. DHMA 15-010</u> that a student must take NSTP 2 in the same college/unit where he/she took NSTP 1. However, the members of the NSTP Council agreed that students who take NSTP 1 and NSTP 2 from different colleges/units starting Academic Year 2022-2023 do not need to file for an appeal for their NSTP classes to be credited. The other provisions of the memorandum still apply including the need for both NSTP 1 and NSTP 2 to be from the same component programs.

At the level of the units, NSTP coordinators will ensure that students who enlist in their NSTP 2 classes are those who have taken NSTP 1 in their units. For students who need to change sections, they will be required to get the approval of the faculty-in-charge (FIC) before enlistment. The approval of the FIC indicates that the change of sections is necessary and that the student can contribute to the NSTP 2 class.

Students who have taken NSTP 1 and NSTP 2 before Academic Year 2022-2023 would still be required to file for an appeal through the <u>UP UTAK</u> website. Moreover, other cases that violate the other provisions of Memorandum No. DHMA 15-010 need to go through the appeal process.
