Dear Prof. Lusong-Oyzon,

The Department of Community Development wishes to clarify the matter regarding pre-requisite courses of CD 121. This is in response to several student inquiries on the matter as some colleges, often through their Student Records Evaluators (SREs), require them to take CD 11 and 100 for CD 121 to be credited as an elective. This is not our interpretation of CD 121's prerequisites, nor does this reflect the spirit of the rule when it was crafted. Based on the Bachelor of Science in Community Development (BSCD) program catalog, the prerequisites for CD 121 are stated as follows: *CD 11, CD 100 or COI*. The department requires BSCD students to take CD 11 and CD 100 before taking CD 121. CD 121 however is also treated by the department as a service course and is offered to non-BSCD majors as an elective. For non-BSCD students, the consent of the instructor (COI) is sufficient for them to be enlisted in the class.

We hope that we are able to clarify this matter.
